Basketball practices will begin next week. There are no practices on Monday, Oct. 31. The first practice will start on Tuesday, Nov. 1 for Boys B and Girls A. The Girls B and Boys A will begin their first practice on Wednesday, Nov. 2 (see the chart below). You can find the basketball schedule online at www.crownoflifemn.org. Click on the "calendar" link at the bottom of the page and select "basketball" from the menu on the right. If you use google calendar you can also add the basketball schedule to your personal calendars by clicking on the "google calendar" link. A hard copy will also be sent home next week. The first game is scheduled for Friday, November 11 @ Belle Plaine. COL does not have school this day, but the game will still be played at its normal time that day. Please let the coach know if your child is unable to make it.

A **study hall** for those teams with the *Late Practice* will be provided before practice on the respective days. Please speak with your child about the importance of the study hall and that it is to be used for completing school assignments and not as a social hour. Simple, healthy snacks may be brought and eaten during the study hall (nothing messy), and all trash is to be thrown away. If there are issues with behavior or following the rules of the study hall supervisor, the privilege will be revoked for that athlete.

Please make note of the mandatory **preseason basketball meeting**. Parents of the B boys will meet right after their practice at 4:45 pm on Wednesday, Nov. 2 and parents of the A girls will meet after their practice ends at 5:45 pm, also on Wednesday, Nov. 2. Parents of the B girls will meet right after their practice at 4:45 pm on Thursday, Nov. 3 and parents of the A boys will meet after their practice ends at 5:45 pm, also on Thursday, Nov. 3. If you have more than one child involved on different teams, you only have to attend the meeting once.

Game/practice schedules for the year will be handed out at the preseason meeting as well as the volunteer sign-up sheet for basketball home games. Make sure your child has proper athletic attire for practice (**non-marking** basketball shoes, athletic shorts and shirt, etc.) If you haven't paid your athletic fee for the year, you can drop the check off in the office with Mrs. Ulrich.
