They played a second game that evening against King of Grace where they lost 26-37. That put them in the consolation bracket on Saturday against Salem, Greenfield. COL won that game 45-40. The consolation championship was next, played against Christ Lutheran. It was a close game; unfortunately the Raiders were unable to come away with the victory, losing by 2. The girls team matched up against Bloomington in their first game of the tournament Friday night. COL lost 15-33. Our girls played their next game against Cross of Christ in the consolation bracket, winning 33-22. That put the girls in the consolation championship game against King of Grace. It was another close game, even going into overtime. COL was unable to win, losing 21-23.
