TRACK: Tomorrow some members of the track team will be traveling to Fridley (address: 6100 W Moore Lake Dr NE, Minneapolis 55432) for an optional track meet. This meet was rescheduled from a previous postponed meet in April. A St. Croix bus will transport the few members who are attending to the track meet. Parents are responsible for bringing their child home at the end of the meet.

This Friday (May 5) all of the COL track team, including the fourth graders, will be competing in the Lutheran Grade School Track Meet held at St. Croix, beginning at 4 pm. There will be no bus transporting the athletes over to St. Croix. All track members are to arrange their own ride over to St. Croix this Friday. COL Track jerseys will be handed out to the athletes on Friday. Have a white undershirt and black shorts to wear along with the jersey. The weather forecast looks fantastic. Remind your child that drinking plenty of water the day before the meet is the best way to prepare their body for the warm temperatures. It is important that the athletes hydrate their bodies Thursday night in preparation for Friday's competition.

The track meet will begin around 4:00 pm, but Crown of Life athletes can head over right away to practice a few events before the meet starts. Parents, please stress to your children the importance of listening to the announcements over the loud speaker for when their events are called, if an event is missed it cannot be made up. The coaches will not be able to find every athlete to remind them which event they should be at. Good Luck to our COL track athletes! COL is in charge of running the Long Jump Pit; if any parents would be able to help, speak with Mr. Ohm.

BOWLING: The COL bowling team will have off this weekend. The meet originally scheduled for Saturday, May 6 has been cancelled. The next meet will Saturday, May 13 held at Concord Lanes in South St. Paul. Here is a quick update from Coach Swiderski on how our teams are doing:

Crown of Life A-Team – is 6-0 in match play with a 27-3 W/L in Game record and averaging over 148 which would be a league record.
