Car line procedure- ALL parents picking up children at dismissal time are required to use our car line procedure. This is for the safety of all of our students. DO NOT park in the spaces facing Crusader Ave. and run across to get your child. Thank you for your cooperation.

School Doors & Parking Lot Gate – The school doors leading into the gym hallway will be locked at 8:30 am each day, and the parking lot gate will be closed at that time as well. The gate will be re-opened at the end of the school day for the car line to come through.

Lunch Program – CKC Good Food provides our lunches. Each day there's a hot meal, entrée salad or sandwich meal available. Meals are \$2.75 for students and includes milk. Fresh fruit and salad bar come with all meals. Milk only is sold for 50¢. Students are to sign up each week by Tuesday morning, for their meal choices for the following week. Sign up sheets will come home each Friday, and should be returned to the teacher by Tuesday morning start of school. **Payments:** Returning families should be using their FeePay accounts. New families will be sent a link by Mr. Herbison, in order to set up your account. This will enable you to deposit money, view your child's balance etc. We also accept cash (in an envelope marked with your child's name and grade) or checks (payable to Crown of Life) in the office at any time. Use the gold mailbox right inside the office door to deposit your payment.

Welcome to the **2015-2016 athletic year!** I would like to thank, in advance, the players, parents and coaches for their commitment, support and assistance to our sports' teams. After School Care

This program is open to all students in Pre-K through grade 8, and is offered from 3:15 – 5:30 pm Monday through Friday (except early release and no school days.)
