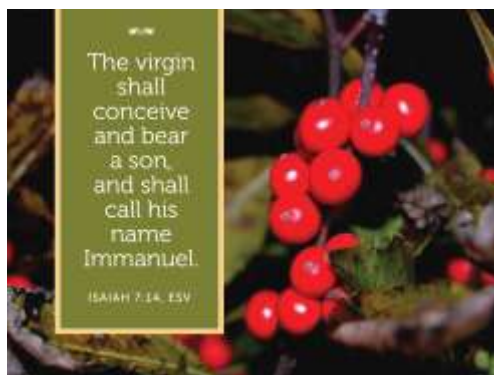
Girls B: 1-2
