**Early Registration for grades K – 8, 2016 / 2017 is going on now!**  
**March 21 – 31, 2016**

We will be taking registrations for next school year from March 21 – 31.

**There is a \$500 per child non-refundable registration fee due with your family's form.** This fee is a deposit toward your family's tuition. After March 31, the registration fee will be \$550 per child.

Please download your form, fill out, then SAVE IT under your family name before sending it back. Hard copies are also available from the school office.**

**Pre-K Registration:** Our Pre-K program has been restructured. Beginning next fall, we will offer full-day Pre-K, consisting of morning and/or afternoon sessions. Parents may choose as many sessions as they need, with a minimum of 2 different day sessions. We will require a minimum of 4 students per session, and a maximum of 20 students per session. The cost is \$20 per half day session, and \$36 per full day session. An \$80 non-refundable registration fee is due with your registration form. Registration forms will be available from the office. Please register by June 15 if possible.

**Easter Egg Hunt** – Saturday, March 26, 10:30 am, at the WSP campus. For ages 3 – 2<sup>nd</sup> grade. No charge, but a canned item for the food shelf is suggested.
