SOCCER: Practices will continue tomorrow from 3:15-4:45 at COL. Soccer uniforms will be handed out to the players at next Monday's practice. Please take the necessary steps to ensure that the uniforms are kept in the best condition possible. COL's **first soccer game** will be next Tuesday (Sept. 11). COL will host Christ Lutheran at a 4:00 game played at the West St. Paul Sports Complex (1650 Oakdale Ave). Players should wear a pair of black athletic shorts along with their COL Soccer Jersey. Also, remember shin guards, cleats and a pair of red soccer socks to wear over the cleats. A water bottle would be a good thing to bring as well. **The day after the first game will be the fall sports team pictures (Wednesday, Sept. 12).** Please bring your washed uniform back to school for team and individual pictures. Order forms will be sent home on Monday.

VOLLEYBALL: There is a lot to catch up on concerning changes and other news about volleyball. First, we were officially accepted into the CAA League for volleyball. CAA game days will be Mondays and Wednesdays starting Sept. 17. The CAA volleyball calendar isn't made/released until the CAA AD meeting next Wednesday, Sept. 12. After that, a new hard copy of the Falls Sports Calendar will be sent home to replace the one you picked up at Open House. There are two other changes that came about this week concerning our Lutheran League: Salem, Stillwater has changed their team status to strictly a "B team" which means the two games against them will only be "B Team" games, and also Good Shepherd informed the League that they will NOT have any volleyball teams this season which means all Good Shepherd games for volleyball will be taken off the game schedule (they will still have a soccer team).

Tomorrow's B Team Game: Tomorrow the B Girls Team will travel to Bloomington to compete in their first games of the season. In order to avoid carline so the players can leave as soon as possible, all B Team volleyball players and their siblings will be released to the West Parking Lot at the normal dismissal time of 3:10 for sports pick up. Bloomington has enough girls on their B Team to split into two teams and so there will be two B Team games played; the first game will be played at 4 pm with the second game to follow around 4:45. All the girls will warm up together at the start of the first game and will sit as a team on the bench for both games.
