Camp Croix Registration Open – See their website at campcroix.org for information or to register. The cost is \$285 for the week (\$260 if you register before April 1.)

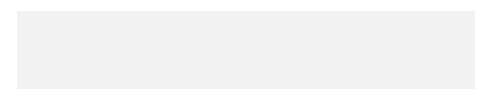
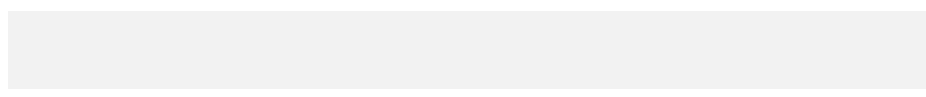

Cheerleading: There is no cheerleading practice this week or next week. With the last home basketball game not until Feb. 1, the next time the cheerleaders will practice will be on Wednesday, January 23. That will give them 3 practices to refresh their cheers and dance routine in preparation for the last home game.

The basketball teams are back at it this week and getting ready to begin their second half of the season with the first games back after break starting this Friday. Before the break the Girls B and Boys A teams competed in a League game as they hosted Salem, Stillwater. The Girls B won 44-2 and Boys A lost 28-42. Also, this past Monday, the Girls B played in their first CAA game since the Christmas break. They traveled to Woodbury to take on St. Ambrose Catholic where COL came away with the victory (59-22).

This Friday COL travels to King of Grace's gym to take on Holy Trinity in the first two games and Bloomington in the last two games. A reminder that all four games are played at King of Grace's gym (address: 6000 Duluth St, Golden Valley, MN 55422). Game times will be a little different than usual. The Girls B will start at 5:30pm against Holy Trinity, followed by the Girls A team which will also play Holy Trinity at 6:30pm. Then the Boys B team will have their game against Bloomington B2 team beginning at 7:30pm and finally the Boys A team will conclude the night's games at 8:30pm against Bloomington A2. **Please make note of the swap of game times between the Girls A and Boys B teams.**

We are approaching several tournament weekends for both the A and B teams. Please make note of those dates and plan accordingly. Both A teams will travel to Mankato on Saturday, Jan. 19. Both B teams have their League Tournament held at West Lutheran High School on Saturday and Sunday, Jan. 26-27. There are also two more tournament weekends in February for the A teams. Brackets have not yet been released for any of the tournaments. As soon as they are they will be sent home with the players as well as put on the Team App under "documents".

Saturday Morning Basketball: Since Mr. Ohm is coaching both girls' teams and because there are Saturday tournaments almost every weekend for one of the two teams starting next Saturday, Saturday Morning Basketball for students in grades 1-4 will need to be pushed back to a later start date.
