Cheerleading: There is no cheerleading practice today. The girls will start back up with their practices next Wednesday, Jan. 23.

The basketball teams traveled to King of Grace's gym to take on two other League schools this past Friday. The Girls' teams played against Holy Trinity in the first two games of the night. Both teams won; Girls B (44 – 6) and Girls A (50 – 7). The boys' teams played next against Bloomington's II teams. The Boys B team lost 7 – 24 and the Boys A team had a great comeback from a 14-point deficit to tie the game up with a little more than a minute to play. It came down to the last play, but unfortunately COL lost by two points (28 – 30). On Monday the Girls B team hosted another CAA game. COL took on Mounds Park Academy and came away with the win (48 – 12).

This Friday COL travels to Mt. Olive, Delano. The games will be played at the Delano Elementary School gym at 678 Tiger Dr, Delano, MN 55328. There is NO BOYS A TEAM game this Friday. COL will only compete in three games. The Girls B will play at 5:30, followed by the Boys B at 6:30 and finally the Girls A at 7:30. Please plan ahead for the longer drive. Traffic and road closures can always be an obstacle when driving across the Metro.

This Saturday, both A Teams will travel to Mankato to compete in the Charger Classic Basketball Tournament hosted at Bethany Lutheran College (700 Luther Dr, Mankato, MN 56001). The tournament rules and other information along with the team brackets have been posted under "documents" on the Team App. The Girls play first this Saturday and the boys begin their tournament play in the afternoon. COL Girls A Team will compete against Resurrection, Rochester at 8:30am in the North Gym. The girls should arrive around 8:00am in time to change and wake up/warm up for the game. The Boys A Team will play their first game against St. Paul, New Ulm at 2:30pm in the South gym. Good luck to our teams this weekend as they travel to Mankato!
