This past weekend the A teams wrapped up their seasons with the annual MLC Invitational Tournament hosted by Martin Luther College in New Ulm. The weekend started with the girls team playing St. Martin's, Watertown, SD. The girls won that game 27-16. That put them in the semifinals game against Bloomington on Saturday. COL lost that game 16-24 sending them to the third place game on Sunday. There the girls matched up against Mt. Olive, Mankato who they lost to by one point in the championship game of a tournament in January. COL started out slow, but made a hard fought comeback, sending the game into overtime. COL outscored their opponent 10-3 in OT, winning the third place trophy. The boys team took on St. John's, Redwood Falls in their first game of the tournament. COL lost that game in OT, 34-39. The next game for the boys was on Saturday against Good Shepherd. It was a close battle ending in another overtime game where COL won by 2 points (31-29). The boys then battled for consolation on Sunday against St. Paul's, New Ulm. COL lost that game 11-47. 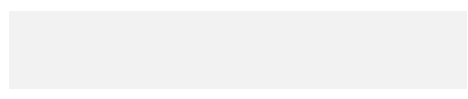
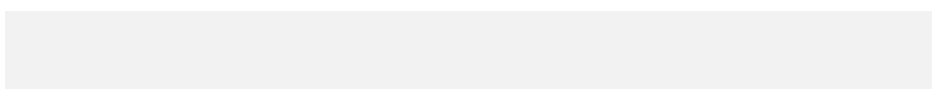
Friday, Feb. 22: Parent/Child Game and Team Recognition Night
