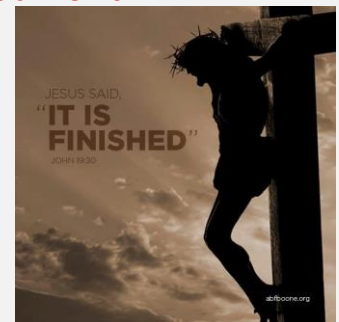

The next track meet (only for athletes in 5-8 graders) will be next Thursday, April 25. The meet will be held at Brooklyn Center (6500 Humboldt Avenue North, Brooklyn Center) beginning at 4:15pm.
