### **TRACK:**

The fourth graders will get their first taste of track today as they begin their joint practice with the regular track team. They will also practice next week Monday and Thursday. Practices are held at St. Croix today and next Monday from 3:30 – 5:00. A bus from St. Croix will come to COL to pick up the track athletes. Students should bring all their bags, backpacks, etc. with them as they leave COL and parents are to pick up their child from St. Croix after practice. Next Thursday (May 2) the 4<sup>th</sup> graders will practice at COL from 3:30 – 4:30. Please plan to pick your 4<sup>th</sup> grader up at COL around 4:30.

Tomorrow is the first track meet of the season. This meet is only for grades 5-8. Tomorrow's track meet will be held at Brooklyn Center (6500 Humboldt Ave. N., Brooklyn Center, 55430). All track athletes will be picked up from COL after school by a St. Croix bus and will be transported to the track meet together as a team. Parents are invited to come and cheer on their child at the meet as well as to take your child home at the conclusion (around 7pm). The bus will also be available (for those who may need a ride) to bring those students back to SCL. Mr. Plath will text the parents of those children who will be using the bus for transportation back to SCL to let them know when they should plan to meet at SCL to pick up their child.
